# **Invitation for IIZ Examiners Selection**

# **COP** in Retirement Fund Trusteeship

- Minimum of a Diploma in Pensions Management (or equivalent) from reputable and accredited institutions.
- Minimum of 2 years work experience in the pensions industry and/or experience in teaching (pensions related courses) at tertiary institutions.
- Relevant higher qualification(s) will be an added advantage.

- Publications in the area of risk management and insurance will be an added advantage.
